RED WINES

GLASS \$7, BOTTLE \$26.....

REX GOLIATH PINOT NOIR *CA W.S. 87*

Red berry perfume with a touch of cinnamon spice, wrapped in a blanket of subtle French oak.

DAVINCI CHIANTI *Tuscany, Italy W.S. 86*

Fruity, with juicy berry and mineral aromas and flavors. Medium body with a clean finish.

SMOKING LOON MERLOT *CA W.S. 85*

Soft and easy to drink with cherry and spice; a hint of root beer, plus just enough depth to keep it interesting.

SNOQUALMIE MERLOT *Columbia Valley, WA W.S. 87*

Crisp and lively. A juicy mouthful of blackberry and currant fruit, shaded by cedary oak and refined tannins.

GLASS \$8, BOTTLE \$28.....

DUCK POND SYRAH *Columbia Valley, WA W.S. 86*

Ripe and juicy, with a root beer note that adds to the blackberry and gentle spice flavors, finishing with mildly chewy tannins.

COLUMBIA CREST SHIRAZ *Two Vines, WA W.S. 86*

Soft, open-textured and appealing for its blackberry and cherry fruit, finishing with a meaty note.

GLASS \$9, BOTTLE \$34.....

CHATEAU STE MICHELLE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Columbia Valley, WA W.S. 87

Earthy and gamy are the first impressions, with ripe blackberry looming behind it. Structure is solid and the texture has polish.

EDNA VALLEY SYRAH *Central Coast Paragon, CA W.S. 87*

Nice balance of ripe cherry and wild berry with supple tannins, presented in a medium-weight style that's easy to drink.

EDMEADES ZINFANDEL *Mendocino County, CA W.S. 88*

A spunky Zinfandel notable for its wild berry, white pepper and mint aromas and its supple raspberry, mocha and anise flavors.

GLASS \$7, BOTTLE \$26.....

MERIDIAN CHARDONNAY *Santa Barbara, CA W.S. 87*

Offers a lively beam of green apple and citrus flavors that are crisp and refreshing, ending with a hint of butterscotch.

KENWOOD SAUVIGNON BLANC *Sonoma, CA W.S. 91*

Intense, focused grapefruit and green apple with a crisp finish.

MONTEVINA PINOT GRIGIO *California W.S. 86*

Fresh and crisp, with citrus and stone fruit aromas and juicy peach and jasmine flavors that end on a spicy note.

HOGUE PINOT GRIGIO *Columbia Valley, WA W.S. 85*

Soft and pretty, with cantaloupe and honey flavors on a dry, easy drinking frame.

GLASS \$8, BOTTLE \$28.....

BERINGER CHARDONNAY *Central Coast, CA 3rd Century W.S. 87*

Refreshing Golden Delicious apple, pear and citrus flavors, with floral and spice flares. Good intensity through the finish.

14 HANDS RIESLING *Washington State W.S. 88*

Aromas of apple blossom and tangerine. Flavors of fresh peaches and Granny Smith apple with a juicy finish.

GLASS \$9, BOTTLE \$34.....

BOLLINI PINOT GRIGIO *Trentino, Italy W.S. 87*

Aromas of minerals and lemon rind followed by a medium-bodied palate, with good fruit and a mineral finish. Real Pinot Grigio here.

KEN FORRESTER SAUVIGNON BLANC *Stellenbosch W.S. 87*

Full, complex, ripe tropical fruit flavors with crisp, dry finish.

KENDALL JACKSON CHARDONNAY *California W.S. 87*

Tropical flavors of mango and pineapple dance with aromas of peach, apple and pear. Richly layered and balanced throughout. Lightly buttered toast headlines the indulgent, lingering finish.
